

21 NCAC 14C .0907 DISQUALIFICATION

The remainder of the members of the Board shall decide whether to disqualify the board member being challenged by the following procedural rules:

- (1) The board member whose disqualification is to be determined will not participate in the decision but may be called upon to furnish information to the remaining members of the Board conducting the hearing.
- (2) The Board shall appoint a member of the Board, the executive director, or any other appropriate person to investigate the allegations of the affidavit, if necessary, and report his or her findings or recommendations.
- (3) The Board shall decide by majority vote, or Board Chair in case of a tie vote, whether to disqualify the challenged individual on the basis of all relevant and appropriate information available to it.
